CONGRESSWOMAN DEBBIE WASSERMAN SHULTZ

Debbie Wasserman Schultz has dedicated her public life to serving South Floridians and standing up for justice, equality, and opportunity wherever and whenever it is threatened. As Florida's first Jewish Congresswoman, she has earned the respect of her colleagues for working tirelessly on behalf of seniors, children, and families for nearly three decades.

Wasserman Schultz serves on the Committee on Oversight and Reform (COR), which has vast jurisdiction over the government and private sector, and plays a key role in overseeing the Trump Administration.

She also chairs the Military Construction and Veterans Affairs Appropriations Subcommittee, where she is committed to ensuring our nation's veterans have the resources and support they need.

As Chief Deputy Whip of the Democratic Caucus, Congresswoman Wasserman Schultz has the unique ability to work with and help lead her colleagues in support of a progressive policy agenda. She has been a tireless defender of Social Security and Medicare and is strongly committed to expanding access to quality and affordable health care, preventing senseless tragedies of gun violence, and defending the fundamental idea that all Americans have the right to be treated equally under the law.

The Hills Democratic Club is awarding the Congresswoman our esteemed "Above and Beyond" Award because of her penchant to go the extra mile when she sees a need that must be met.

Most recently, the Congresswoman has stepped in to lead with legislation and publicity working to control and discourage flair ups of anti- Semitism and other vile acts of hatred and violence.

Congresswoman Wasserman Schultz attended the University of Florida where she served as president of the Student Senate and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science in 1988 and a Master's Degree in 1990.

She has been married to Steve Schultz for more than 20 years and together they have three children.

Wasserman Schultz has said that representing the people of Florida's 23rd district – soon to be Florida's 25th district in January - is the greatest privilege of her professional life. Congresswoman Wasserman Schultz resides with her family in Weston



BEAM FURR Broward County Commissioner

Beam Furr is a Broward County Commissioner representing District Six, which comprises parts of Hollywood, Hallandale Beach, West Park, Pembroke Park, Dania Beach and Fort Lauderdale. He served as Mayor of Broward County for the 2017- 2018 term after being selected by his fellow commissioners. He was first elected to the Broward County Commission in 2014. Prior to that, he was a Hollywood City Commissioner for 12 years.

As an elected official, he has focused on environmental issues, early childhood education, transportation, housing, economic opportunity and the arts.

Beam has served on the Broward County Children's Services Council for six years. He co-chairs the Campaign for Grade Level Reading and is on the Executive Committee of the Metropolitan Planning Organization and the South Florida Regional Planning Council. He also co-Chairs the Climate Change Task Force and the Solid Waste Working Group.

Commissioner Furr was a teacher in the Broward County School System for 25 years. During that time, he taught social studies, before becoming a librarian for Flanagan High School. In the early 1990's, he owned and ran the Downtown Recording Studio in Hollywood, where he got to record his own songs for free..

Our Club is honoring Beam with the "Democratic Humanitarian Award" because so much of what he focuses on are compassionate needs of our community as well as the planet and our environment - all of which are Democratic priorities!

Beam rew up in South Florida and now lives in Hollywood with his wife, Shelli Edwards, and his the proud dad of his daughter Eliza.



MURIEL KIRSCHNER Hills Democratic Club VP

Muriel Horowitz Zeitlin Kirschner was born in 1928 in the Bronx as a member of the family clan of the Horowitz Margaretten matzoh company, but was taken to live on Miami Beach when she was 9years old on doctors orders.

Her parents were very active Democrats imbuing Muriel with the spirit of our party and emphasizing that we can't stand still when bad things are happening.

When her mom had to return to NY, Muriel was enrolled at the Lear School in Miami as a young dormitory student, becoming very independent at a young age.

She met and married Dr Harold Zeitlin, a young Dentist, and she dropped out of Columbia University when he opened his practice in freezing Cold upstate New York, where he grew up

Harold went along with Muriel's abandoning the cold weather to set up their home with their three young kids Cindy, Lee and Bob in South Florida, choosing Hollywood because they wanted to be part of the newly built Hollywood Playhouse, where they acted, directed and did every job necessary for the storied volunteer theater.

And Muriel, as a young widow of 36 years old, cut her teeth on Democratic activism by marching and demonstrating against the Vietnam War., for voting rights and inclusivity. She supported her family by working at Temple Beth El as the Student Youth Advisor.

She and her second husband Sam Kirschner continued their involvement in the theater and cut their teeth on organized political activity when they hooked up with their friends, Murray and Ruth Cohen and our Hills Democratic Club.

Since the sixties, Muriel and Sam marched for Democratic principles in demonstrations all over Florida, gone to conventions and have been the backbone of our club, doing everything needed to run an organization. Muriel worked at the polls at election time, organized mailings, hosted meeting in their home, attended almost every rally they could find, supported candidates, hosted phone banks, walked door to door to Get Out the Vote and organized the attendance And RSVP's and manning the front desk at every meeting.




